

WORSHIP COLLAB

- Collaborate with others and sing a song or multiple songs that are in the Christian genre.
 Example: https://youtu.be/nt29wOTsZPE
- There will be no age limit restriction or limitation on the maximum number of participants. However, a minimum of three different vocalists are needed.
- At minimum, two vocalists must be part of a PYFA member church.
- A group must sing at least one stanza and chorus of a song or at least 2 stanzas of a song.
- Secular lyrics of any kind will not be allowed. Styles of rap/rock/alternative music are not allowed when performing the songs.
- Music Videos cannot exceed 10 minutes
- Scoring would be based on two components an Officials' Choice and People's Choice:
 - Officials' Choice would be scored by Officials, Talent Committee and PYFA Church representatives. The score would be based upon:
 - Melody/Vocal Tone (3), Rhythm (3), Performance/Creativity/Delivery (4).
 - People's Choice would be based on interactions over Facebook. A score would be based on the combination of:
 - Likes, Comments, Shares and Views received over a 2 week (14 day) period from September 14, 2020 to September 28, 2020.
- Submit videos through Google Drive. Fill out the Google Form (https://bit.ly/3hoVaZq) and include the Google Drive download link.
- Videos should be submitted by September 5, 2020.
- Videos should be submitted in the final form and PYFA will not be responsible for making any edits to the submitted video.
- All videos should be original and should not have appeared online prior to submission.
- The PYFA Media team will post all videos on PYFA's Facebook Page on the same date on September 14, 2020. The order of posting the videos would be in the order that videos were submitted through the Google Form.
- Once videos are submitted, PYFA will retain the rights to the video. Submitters would need
 permission to publish their video online. After PYFA's Got Talent competition is completed,
 the rights will revert back to the original submitter.

- This competition is open to participants who attend a PYFA member church in the following age categories -

 Seniors
 Born January 1, 2004 – December 31, 2006

 Born January 1, 1995 – December 31, 1999

- Three Officials' Choice prizes (1st place, 2nd place, and 3rd place) per age group listed above will be awarded to the top poems as determined by the judges.
 - The Officials' Choice prize will be awarded based on scoring by PYFA Officials,
 Talent Committee, and PYFA church representatives.
 - The following judging criteria will be utilized to evaluate submissions.
 - Relevance to the theme 50%
 - Creativity/Style and Originality 30%
 - Coherence of form and structure (harmony of words, flow) 10%
 - Clarity of imagery and language 10%
 - TOTAL 100%
- Submit poem, in Microsoft Word format, via Google Forms (https://bit.ly/3hoVaZq) by September 5, 2020.
- All poems submitted must be original and written solely by the participant, without assistance from others.
- Poem submissions will be disqualified if they contain expletives, or ideas opposing the gospel.
- Poem submissions may not have been previously published.
- By submitting an entry for this competition, participants grant permission to PYFA to share / publicize their entry. After PYFA's Got Talent competition is completed, the rights will revert to the original submitter.

 - Creativity/Style and Originality 30%
 - Aesthetic quality (design, composition, color/tones) 10%
 - Professional quality (neatness and craft) 10%
 - TOTAL 100%
- Submit image submission, in Microsoft Word format, via Google Forms (https://bit.ly/3hoVaZq) by September 5, 2020.
- All images submitted must be original and drawn solely by the participant, without assistance from others.
- Image submissions will be disqualified if they contain hateful images, or concepts opposing the gospel.
- Image submissions may not have been previously published.
- Image submissions may not contain words.
- By submitting an entry for this competition, participants grant permission to PYFA to share / publicize their entry. After PYFA's Got Talent competition is completed, the rights will revert to the original submitter.
